

## **John Dellroy Band – Boundless Musical Diversity and International Influences**

The John Dellroy Band is a dynamic pop/rock outfit from Austria that captivates audiences with its distinctive blend of alternative rock, singer-songwriter elements, folk, blues, and country. Since its formation in 2009, the band has combined catchy pop ballads with energetic indie and rock sounds—showcasing musical diversity without limits.

Their debut album, *“A New Life Has Begun”* (2013), quickly put them on the map. Collaborating with Grammy®-nominated producer Peter Roberts from Los Angeles and with the single *“She”* - which received airplay on over 150 US radio stations and reached #27 on the FMQB Top 200 Charts—the band has steadily attracted growing international interest.

The John Dellroy Band also shines on stage: whether performing at renowned festivals like the Danube Island Festival in Vienna or on smaller stages in Germany and Austria, their captivating presence wins over audiences. With the 2019 release of the single *“Burning Desire”* they continued their success, garnering increased radio attention in the USA, Great Britain, and other European countries.

After a pandemic-induced hiatus, the band reunited about a year ago with a partially refreshed lineup and is now working intensively on new songs. Exciting live performances are planned for 2025 to delight fans once again.

Led by the charismatic frontman John Dellroy (vocals, acoustic guitar, harmonica) and supported by Franz Königshofer (electric/acoustic guitar, backing vocals), Walter Indra (keyboard), Andreas Hausleitner (bass, backing vocals), and Eytan Reif (drums), the current lineup brings together international talent and a shared passion for innovative rock music.
